You can sit in the sun in your local park, you can drive to other destinations, you can even play sports but
only with members _____.
You must obey the rules on social distancing and to enforce those rules we will increase the _____
for the small minority who break them.
And so every day, with ever increasing data, _____ the **R***** and

conditions I have _____, then in the next few weeks and months we may be able to go further.

***** What is R?**

The **Reproduction number** is a way of rating a disease's ability to spread.
It's the number of people that one infected person will pass the virus on to, on average
Measles has one of the highest numbers in town with a reproduction number of 15 in populations without
immunity. It can cause explosive outbreaks.
The new coronavirus, known officially as Sars-CoV-2, has a reproduction number of about three, but
estimates vary.
